

Hanging and Framing Options:

All pieces come on either wood or aluminum panels, and may be purchased with or without framing. Aluminum panels or hardboard panels that are 1/4" deep or less must be framed to be hung. The majority of hardboard panels that I use are cradled, meaning they have a wooden frame on the back that looks like this photo on the right. This cradling allows the piece to be hung directly on the wall if you choose.



I personally love floater frames. Floater frames have a gap around the piece, making the piece appear to “float” within the frame. They look like the frame on the left.

My daughter Grace will create a floater frame for your piece if you would like. You can see several examples of her framed pieces on the gallery page. She offers frames in these finishes, left to right, Antique White, Classic Oak, Red Mahogany, and Jacobean. The two light frames have a carbon black interior line, to define the shadow between the painting and the frame (See example on the left.)

The frames are 2” - 3” deep (depending on the size of the painting). The wood is sanded, stained, and sealed with a clear sealer. If you opt for framing, Grace will build your frame to perfectly fit the painting and mount your painting within the frame, attaching hardware so that it is ready to hang when received.
