Process Photos

Process photos are photos taken as your piece is being created. I use these photos to see the piece with "fresh eyes" as I work. Historically, painters used mirrors to look at a reflection of their paintings as the painting was being developed. This practice allows some distance, and sometimes, you can see problems or strengths with the work that you simply can't see sitting directly in front of the piece, hour after hour. When you see this series of photographs of one of my paintings, you can see the painting at all stages of the work. You see changes made, and the choices I made throughout the painting process.
